



GUIDELINES FOR ADULT REFERRAL REGISTER

- The Adult Referral Officer shall accept any adult Finnish Lapphund (cross breeds or other are not eligible for this service) for referral to prospective owners if the following conditions are fulfilled:
- If the Breeder of the Finnish Lapphund seeking a new home:
 - a) Cannot be contacted
 - b) Doesn't wish to assist in the re-homing of the Dog
 - c) There is no contract/agreement on the Dog specifying a clause in accordance with re-homing
- That the current caretakers of the Dog can prove Ownership.
- That the current owners understand the FLCV does not vet prospective new owners and take no responsibility for any prospective new owners. The current owners **must** take responsibility for vetting the prospective new owners.
- That the current owners fill in the Adult Referral Form and submit to the FLCV Adult Referral Officer.
- The Adult Referral Officer will contact the Webmaster to place the Finnish Lapphund seeking a new home onto the FLCV website with any information supplied by the current owners.

DISCLAIMER

- The FLCV Referral Service will not knowingly assist in the re-homing of dogs which have shown aggression towards people.
- The FLCV Referral Service will not knowingly assist in the adoption of an Finnish Lapphund for the purpose of breeding.
- The FLCV Referral Service will not knowingly be involved in referral of Finnish Lapphunds being sold for profit by the original owner.
